1. Timings for plant growth are based on sowing seeds, but transplanting healthy seedlings into fertile soil will shorten these by about 2 -weeks. Seedlings are temporarily set back when replanted.

Do not try to transplant root vegetables such as carrots , silverbeet or radish. They invariably run to seed prematurely.

2. Success assumes regular watering and applications of a good liquid fertiliser such as Seasol fertiliser concentrate or pelleted fertiliser such as Dynamic Lifter for vegetables.
